

4. ACTIONS by PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

- Hospital refurbished for COVID-19 (2 weeks)
- Biostatistical projections, Reproduction number calculations (R) and modelling (Ministry of Health, CCP, UCR, UNA)
- Treatment with plasma from recovered patients (first patient received plasma on May 23) (Public Hospital System - CCSS)
- Preparation and distribution of sample collection kits and PPE masks (UCR, TEC)
- Psychosocial support by voluntary mental health care professionals (CR College of Psychology, UNA)
- Economic support for unemployed families (Central Government)
- Food delivery to vulnerable populations (Ministry of Education, local governments)
- No charge for data if connected to public web sites.



5. RESEARCH by PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

- Molecular studies of SARS-CoV-2 variants by WGS (INCIENSA)
- Separation of neutralizing antibodies of patients' plasma for experimental treatments (ICP-UCR)
- Immunization of horses to separate neutralizing antibodies for experimental treatments (ICP-UCR)
- Research on manufacture of ventilators (UCR, TEC)
- Research on psychosocial effects of the pandemic in health care personnel and the general population (Costa Rican Mission to the UN, UCR, UNA).
