

**The InterAmerican Network of Academies of Science (IANAS) call for the
Anneke Levelt-Sengers Prize for Women in Science in the Americas**

The IANAS Women for Science (WfS) Working Group is calling for the 6th edition of the prize for young women scientists. The Prize is named after Anneke Levelt-Sengers in recognition of her outstanding work devoted to promoting women for science in the Americas.

IANAS is an affiliated Regional Network of the InterAmerican Partnership (IAP), therefore the prize will be coordinated and supported by both these organizations. Prize

The winning nominee will be allocated a U\$S 3000 prize to spend on suitable activities related to her research work. The biography of the winner will be posted in the IANAS-WfS webpage, and a certificate award will be issued.

Eligibility criteria:

1. Female PhD
2. Under 40 years-old (before 31/07/2025)
3. Performing scientific work in her country in the fields of Exact, Natural, Technological, Life, or Social Sciences

Honoring the principles of our organizations, the Prize will be for the women scientists or engineers of the following countries: Bolivia, CAS (Caribbean), Colombia Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua, Panamá, Perú, Uruguay, and Venezuela.

Application process:

The Science Academies of the countries listed above are invited to nominate **ONE** candidate from their respective country.

The candidate should apply through her Academy of Science, in English, with:

- CV, limited to 5 pages, including name of graduate degree institution, research and work experience, publications, presentations, etc.
- Short summary (up to 250 words) of her research accomplishments and a brief description of the plans to use the award in case of being the winner.
- Academies should inform the IANAS office of their proposed candidate in a letter signed by the President of the Academy and send all other application documents before the deadline indicated in the calendar to:

Selection process:

A Selection Committee will be designated by IANAS-WfS, with highly recognized scientists from all non-participating countries and countries that are not presenting any candidate in this call.

Calendar Dates:

Application period opens: July 1, 2025

Application deadline: August 4, 2025.

The decision should be made before August 22, 2025 and the winner will be notified.
